Due to the success of the **Make History Work** education programme in October 2010, IRIE! dance theatre in partnership with **Kon-Kon-Te Cultural Group** will be delivering **Make History Work for October 2011**.

The programme will focus on the following creative and cultural tools to support the sessions:

Games, Sayings, Songs and Stories

Although each of the above areas will be touched on in the programme they will all have their individual Scheme of Work and a teaching pack for pre- and post-lesson planning & development.

Make History Work will take place at the **Moonshot Centre, Angus Street, Fordham Park, New Cross SE14 6LU**.

The programme will run for 5 days (10th-14th October 2011) with workshops available in the mornings and afternoons.

The fee for the session is £200, which includes a scheme of work and teaching pack with ideas on how you can continue the work in your classroom.

Bookings will be taken on a first-come, first-serve basis, so to avoid disappointment, book your place as soon as possible.
